Call for

'Innovative Aromatherapy Practice'

RULES



The Gattefossé Foundation organizes a call for posters to select the most innovative aromatherapy practice/protocol – worldwide - offered to recipients within a healthcare settings.

Participants should send between May and October 15th, 2024, an electronic poster presenting a specific aromatherapy practice/protocol that showed beneficial effect for recipients.

In addition, in the application form, they must download a short video presentation to explain why and how the practice/protocol was developed (2 min max).

The goal of this competition is to share and celebrate innovative aromatherapy practice worldwide that can benefit the community.

Submission Timeline

- Deadline for submission of electronic posters: 15th october 2024
- Announcement of the 5 finalists : 15th november 2024
- Aroma Showcase Event: 10th december 2024

Who can apply?

Certified aromatherapists or health professionals trained in aromatherapy working in healthcare settings.

It is imperative that Aromatherapy is supported by an institution. This program is targeting team work and not an independent healthcare professional.

How to apply?

Participants must follow the instructions to create their e-poster and record a short video.

They must fill the form and upload the documents.

Each candidate should guarantee the accuracy and veracity of the information that he/she provides. Any application that is illegible, incomplete, or not fitting the eposter format and content, shall be considered void.

Five languages are accepted for the eposter and the oral presentation = French, English, German, Japanese and Portuguese. Submissions should be done on the Gattefossé Foundation website.

Election rules

A jury – independent experts appointed by the Foundation - will select 5 finalists based on their eposter and the video. The main criterion will be the innovative aspect of the treatment and its benefit for recipients. A second criterion will be the quality of the protocol description: it must be reproducible by a reader!

These 5 finalists will be invited to present their practice in a 10 minutes oral presentation during an digital event called "Aroma Showcase" - a free online event. The event is scheduled on December 10th, 2024, and is organized by the Gattefossé Foundation.

At the end of the show, participants can vote – only once - electronically to select their preferred candidates amongst the 5 finalists. Participants must attend all presentations and vote at the end of the event. The winner is the candidate who has the highest score combining the participant votes (weight 60%) and the jury votes (weight 40%).

Communication

The winner will be announced at the end of the event on December 10th. He will receive a plaque of recognition with an award of 1000€ for their institution. The 4 other finalists will receive a consolation prize of 250€ from the Foundation.

After the show, only the ranking of candidates will be communicated, not the numbers.

All participants must accept the general data protection regulation (GDPR) and agree if they are finalists to give the rights to the Gattefossé Foundation to publish their e-poster on its website.
